AIMS & OBJECTIVES

Course aim:

This fun introductory course will allow you to explore theatre techniques collectively with the aim to re-connect with yourself, others and with our environment. Using our imagination, we will go through an introduction to theatre and ways of expressing ourselves using games, improvisation, and scene study. We will build confidence, communication, listening and observation skills. From there we will experiment with character creation and scene work, on your own and with others.

Learning Objectives: To successfully complete the course, you will:

- Attend a minimum of 6 sessions. 1.
- 2. Reflect on your own learning.
- 3. Contribute to group conversations.
- 4. Participate in group exercises and games including improvisation, physical theatre, movement and voice-based practices.
- 5. Create a character or characters based on prompts.
- 6. Develop scenes from provided scripts, texts or improvisation.
- 7. Perform scenes.
- Respond positively to feedback. 8.
- Provide constructive feedback to others. 9.
- 10. Demonstrate effective interpersonal skills with others showing listening skills, tolerance, patience and respect.



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
